Al-Anon is not allied with any sect, denomination, political entity, organisation, or institution; does not engage in any controversy; neither endorses nor opposes any cause. There are no dues for membership.

Al-Anon is self-supporting through its own voluntary contributions.

Al-Anon has but one purpose: to help families of alcoholics. We do this by practicing the Twelve Steps, by welcoming and giving comfort to families to alcoholics, and by giving understanding and encouragement to the alcoholic.

When we list a group, at their request, there is an informal agreement that the group will abide by Al-Anon's Traditions and keep its doors open to any Al-Anon member.
